

The Award

The Ridgedale Federal Credit Union scholarship is an award of \$3000 to be paid jointly to the winning student and the student's chosen accredited educational institution. There will be one student chosen to receive the \$3,000 award.

Eligibility

The applicant **<u>must be a member</u>** in good standing at Ridgedale Federal Credit Union and must be enrolled as a high school senior at the time of the application.

To open your membership savings account, go to RidgedaleFCU.org for a membership application or we can provide an application for you. Complete and sign the application, provide us with an official ID, and \$5.00 to open your account. You will receive access to all the credit union benefits! You can open your account Monday – Friday 9:00 am – 4:00 pm. At 124 South Ridgedale Ave, East Hanover, NJ.

Scholarship funds must be used for tuition only at an accredited educational institution for the upcoming 2024/2025 school year.

Application Process

Eligible members must complete this scholarship application in its entirety and return it to Ridgedale Federal Credit Union no later than the June 4, 2024, deadline. Send completed application to Ridgedale Federal Credit Union, 124 South Ridgedale Ave., East Hanover, NJ 07936, ATTN: Pam Callender, or email to <u>scholarship@Ridgedalefcu.org</u>. A student may submit only one application. The application must be completed and signed by the student and parent/guardian (see page 2).

The signed and completed application must be submitted with the following:

- An official high school transcript that includes a cumulative GPA of completed marking periods as of date of submission.
- The completed Teacher Reference portion of the application (see page 4). It must be completed and signed by one of the applicant's teachers.

The application (page 2 and 3 of this form), transcript, and Teacher Reference (page 4) must be returned to Ridgedale Federal Credit Union by the application deadline: June 4, 2024. If any portion of the application is incomplete or not included, the applicant will be disqualified.

Selection Process

Judging is based on academic performance, extracurricular activities, community service/ involvement, references, and leadership roles. The credit union will notify winners of the scholarship by June 14, 2024, via email and US mail.
